<b>86<sup>th</sup> ST NW</b> Grass is bright green in areas??	Nutrition. Areas need more spraying
<b>17<sup>th</sup> Drive NW</b> Extensive Dollar weed in rear yard	Will be treated – also next door neighbor has outbreak
<b>17<sup>th</sup> Drive NW - FOLLOW UP</b> Ganaderma Noted on Foxtail tree next garage.	Tree Removed
<b>17<sup>th</sup> Dr NW</b> Palm Fronds hitting roof ? Queen Palm Homeowner questions if missed in annual trimming ?	Palm too tall for WestBay to trim. Advise homeowner
<b>17<sup>th</sup> Drive FOLLOW UP</b> Noted on walk 1 dead Canary Date Palm ( not top) and one behind ( right side back of house) it that appears to be dying, Recommended removal	Will have Nicole notify homeowner Tree has not been removed
<b>85<sup>th</sup> Court NW</b> Brown areas of grass by driveway – Insects? Irrigation – drip line by lanai still broke	Area will fill in naturally.
<b>85<sup>th</sup> Court NW</b> Bushes by Back Flow meter needs trimming - ? wasps?	<i>Bushes have been trimmed. No sign of wasps</i>
<b>85<sup>th</sup> Court NW</b> White flies in front bushes by driveway	Matt will have the insecticide people look at to possibly spray again
<b>85 Ct NW Follow up</b> Extensive vine in Fichus  Any change?	Ray introduced himself to new owner. No evidence of vine. Oleanders need to be trimmed
<b>85<sup>th</sup> Court NW</b> Backyard has bare /dead grass areas	Area too shaded for grass to grow. Suggest to homeowner to resod in summer
<b>8513 19<sup>th</sup> Ave NW FOLLOW UP</b> <b>Fichus needs trimming</b>	Fichus has white fly – Matt will treat

<b>Homeowner questions when was ficus treated? Next steps ?</b>	White fly noted on house at 8517 – will treat Fichus is at standard height
<b>19<sup>th</sup> Ave NW</b> 2 leaks in Zone 2 of irrigation by lamp post. Did WB damage dog poop bucket?	Matt will have irrigation checked. WB not responsible for decorative items in landscaping beds

Questions:

Matt suggested spraying again of 19<sup>th</sup> Ave Ficus hedge – still showing signs of white fly damage.

Matt suggested recommending to residents to cut back on watering over the winter. This would perhaps cut down on the number of weeks (e.g. dollar weeds) that seem to grow in dark, damp areas.
