19th Ave. NW Side hedge cut too short and beds not edged	Hedges trimmed to window height. Bed has been edged.
19th Ave. NW Check on white fly infestation on ficus hedge. Also requested hibiscus to be staked – not an HOA responsibility.	Hedges were treated with a root treatment and should recover. Someone had staked the hibiscus.
85th Ct. NW Sprinkler head on R side of house. Ficus hedge too high. Shady Lady needs trim.	Irrigation will inspect sprinkler head today. Ficus will be trimmed on next cycle but may not be as low as homeowner would like. Shady lady is outside fence – will pass to Ray King, but looks fine.
FOLLOW UP 86TH Ct. Have oleanders and hedge on back wall been trimmed? Bees?	These were skipped the last time because of wasp nests. Matt will spray again before they are trimmed.
Fruit from palm trees lying on ground and smelling and attracting rats	Removal would be a homeowner responsibility.
