Our biggest challenge in 2021 and will likely continue to be in 2022 is the landscaping responsibility. Landscape companies, like many smaller businesses have faced labor shortages and increased costs. They have little choice other than to pass these increased costs onto consumers like Wisteria Park. Our increased fees for 2022 were mainly a result of increased costs for this service.

HVAC TIP FROM THE EXPERT

Each homeowner faces significant expenses from HVAC maintenance and replacement. To hopefully help us save on these expenses I've asked our resident HVAC expert Steve Crawford of BACARR HVAC for a tip on extending the life of our systems. Steve says...

"Change your filter June through October once a month and then every two months from November through May. And also every other month throughout the year pour 1 cup of Bleach followed by 2 quarts of warm water down the condensation drain if you have access."
